Review of the 2nd TPM in Bucharest

The two-day Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) in Bucharest was a success! The team dived into discussions on key project elements, focusing on WP4 (Expert Network) and WP2 (Handbook) during a productive session at Jilava prison. An inspiring highlight was the hands-on practice of pedagogical exercises with the prisoners, combined with an in-depth exploration of the theoretical framework, particularly the comfort zone model for resocialization, where a shared definition was crafted. The day ended with an intriguing prison tour, offering practical insights into experiential education.

On Day 2, we kicked off with breakout sessions, including the first WP4 Expert Network meeting, bringing together prison staff from six countries, and a WP1 management strategies discussion. Partners also unveiled initial insights from the PERSPEKTIVE Handbook and introduced innovative educational concepts for prison staff. Collaboration is at the heart of our progress, and we're excited to share that a dedicated EPAL Community PERSPEKTIVE site is on the horizon!



During the guided tour of the modern and historical prison sections, it was possible to discover the past and present of criminal justice and talk about the future.



Project partners and inmates had the opportunity to try out three experiential education exercises themselves and reflect on them together.

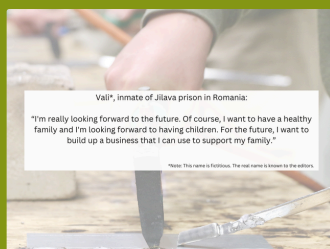
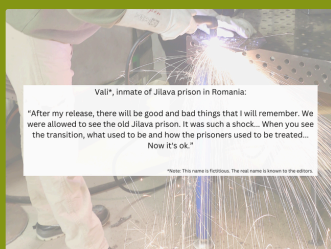
This opportunity for open dialogue was incredibly valuable, and we're already looking forward to reuniting in Reykjavik and Izmir next year!
