## Fourth Transnational Project Meeting in Aliğa, TÜRKİYE

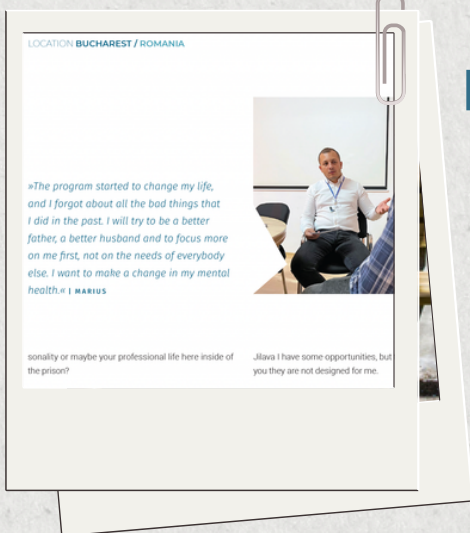
The fourth Transnational Project Meeting (TPM) of the Erasmus+ PERSPEKTIVE project was held in İzmir/Aliğa, Türkiye, bringing together project partners, experts and stakeholders from several European countries to collectively reflect on the work accomplished so far and to shape the final phase of the initiative in a collaborative way. Over the course of the meeting, participants revisited the project's central ambition of supporting the social and professional reintegration of offenders, while carefully analysing how the developed outputs respond to the concrete realities of prison environments in different national contexts and legal frameworks. In this sense, the 4th TPM functioned not only as an administrative checkpoint, but also as a space for in-depth dialogue on how to further enhance the quality, usability and transferability of the project results for prison staff, NGOs and other relevant actors working with (ex-)offenders. The event was hosted by the Turkish partner Multi ACT, who designed a comprehensive programme that combined intensive working sessions, partner discussions and evaluation activities with local field experiences and institutional visits in the İzmir/Aliğa region, thus allowing participants to directly connect project aims with everyday correctional practices and to gain first-hand insight into the Turkish context.



The 4th meeting in İzmir brought the PERSPEKTIVE partners together to share first insights into the handbook and magazine and powerfully strengthening the European expert network around offender reintegration.

## Mega – Memory

In Izmir, first day focused on hands-on, experience-based learning. Participants worked through several experiential education exercises, including “Mega – Memory” and “Reality Check” (source: METALOG). We introduced and practiced standardized observation, discussed common observation errors, and outlined principles for fair competence assessment.



## PERSPEKTIVE Expert Network

In parallel, the PERSPEKTIVE Expert Network convened to discuss its future direction and possible institutionalisation — including ideas for follow-up projects.

To round off the meeting and strengthen ties within the consortium, we explored the archaeological site of Pergamon, a shared cultural highlight that offered space for informal exchange, teambuilding and networking.
